

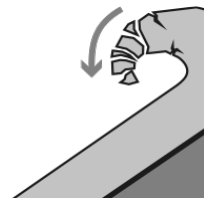

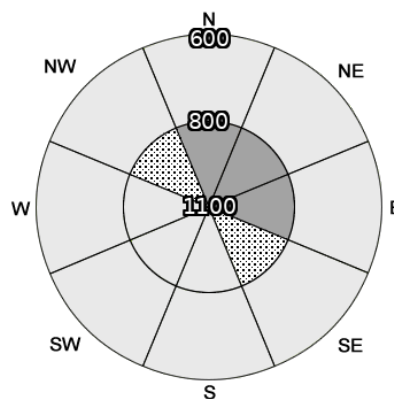
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Areas of weak windslab will continue to build and become more widespread on all steep, mainly North to Easterly aspects above 800 metres. Cross-loading is expected in steep terrain features on selected SE and NW aspects. Cornices will continue to grow above all very steep lee slopes. Much better stability on all wind exposed slopes and ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snowfall is expected on high ground. The freezing level will be around 700 metres. Overnight very strong South-West winds will be strong West-South-Westerly
