



#### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weaknesses will persist in the deeper accumulations on Westerly to Northerly aspects mainly above 1000 metres with gully exits and coire rims especially affected. Here also cornices will be liable to collapse. Additionally, redistributed snow will form unstable windslab on North-East to South-East aspects mostly above 950 metres. Below this level snowpack stability will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight on light variable winds, these will die out by day break. Dry during the day with West-South-West winds increasing moderate to strong at higher levels, veering to the West through the afternoon. The freezing level will fluctuate between 400 and 500 metres.
