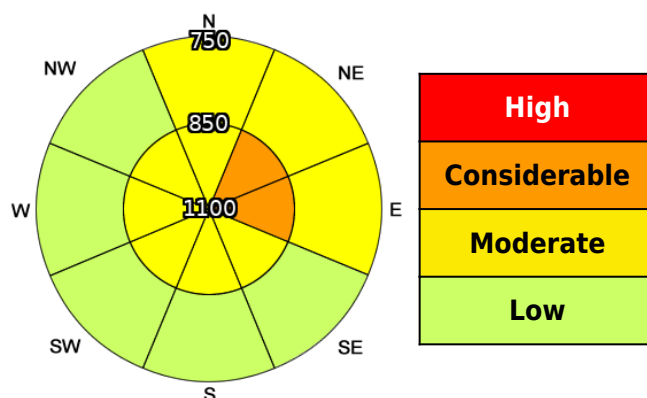

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of weak windslab will persist above 850 metres, the underlying snowpack will remain poorly bonded. Some new windslab development is also likely on steep mainly North East and Easterly aspects and in sheltered gully flanks and exists. Cornices over all lee slopes will remain fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cool with the Freezing Level around 400 metres. Further light snow showers are forecast from first light; the accompanying Westerly winds will then strengthen and become West-South-West, as the day progresses.

Comments

Deep unstable graupel layers noted today in snowpack on North-Easterly aspects.
