

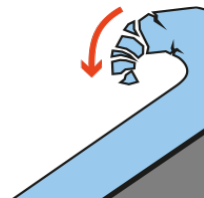

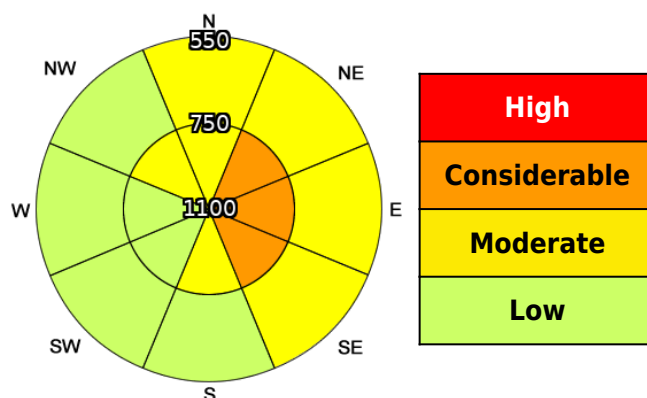
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Persistent poor stability on steep NE through E to SE aspects above 750m where avalanches are likely. Of particular concern will be wind sheltered steep coire rims, gullies and ridge flanks in these locations. Growing, weak and collapse prone cornices will overhang most of these steeper places. Better stability on all windward aspects and ridge crests. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate snow showers throughout the forecast period. Cold with moderate WSW winds strengthening later and becoming W.
