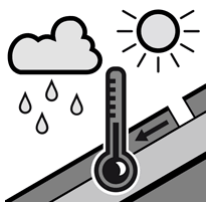


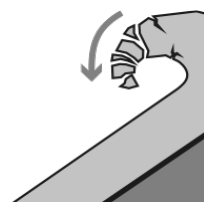

##### Avalanche Problems



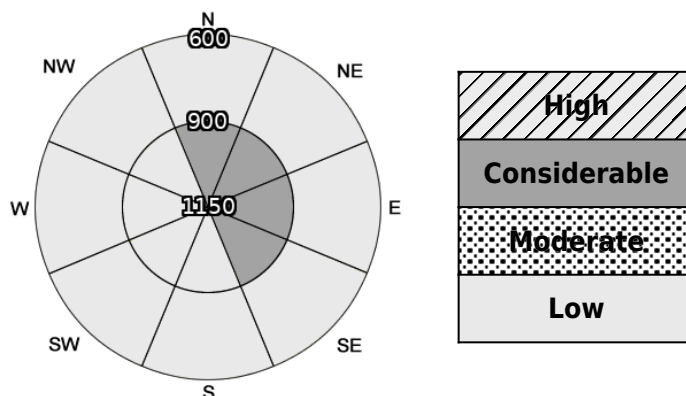
Wet Snow

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Avalanches are likely in steeper, wind sheltered locations on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be at risk of collapse and will threaten the slopes below. Elsewhere, surface layers will become wet but the snow will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Limited snowfall during the early hours will turn to light rain as the freezing level rapidly rises above the summits, reaching 1800 metres by late morning. The variable South-West then Southerly winds will gradually increase in strength to become very strong by the end of the period.

##### Comments

Runout zones under steeper terrain should be avoided tomorrow. Cornice collapse expected.
