

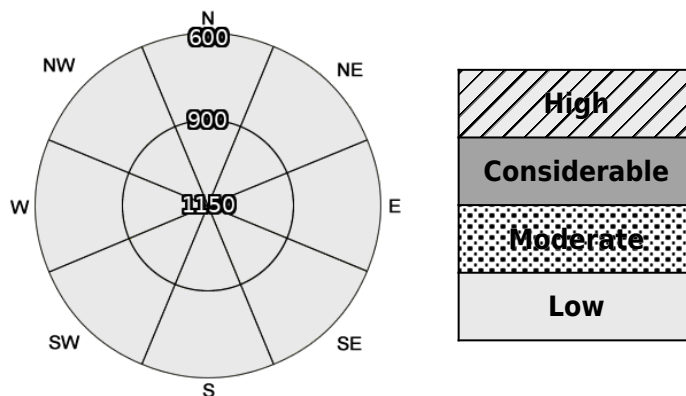
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 09/03/2020

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old wet snow will develop a strong crust in the colder conditions and will be well bonded and stable throughout. Shallow new accumulations will start to form late in the period on North and North-East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight and for most of the day. Light snow arriving mid-afternoon on strong South-South-Westerly winds. Freezing level 650 metres overnight, rising to 850 metres during the afternoon.

#### Comments

Fluctuating freezing level forecast for next 48 hours with constant gale or severe gale force winds on highest summits.
