Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight wet snow instability on steep N to E aspects above 850m. Some further potential for minor full depth avalanche activity on selected very steep crags. Better stability in all locations with the onset of colder conditions in the morning and prior to the arrival of snowfall. New marginally stabilised windslab will build progressively during the day on most steep NE to E aspects above 900m. Wind exposed slopes will be scoured and well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snowfall turning to rain at all levels overnight. Further snowfall during the morning. Mild overnight then progressively colder. Strong WSW later W winds.

Comments

Wet snow instability anticipated overnight Monday into Tuesday. Further potential for minor full depth avalanche activity on the very steep crags in Upper Coire Ardair.
