

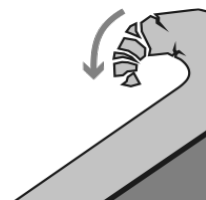

##### Avalanche Problems



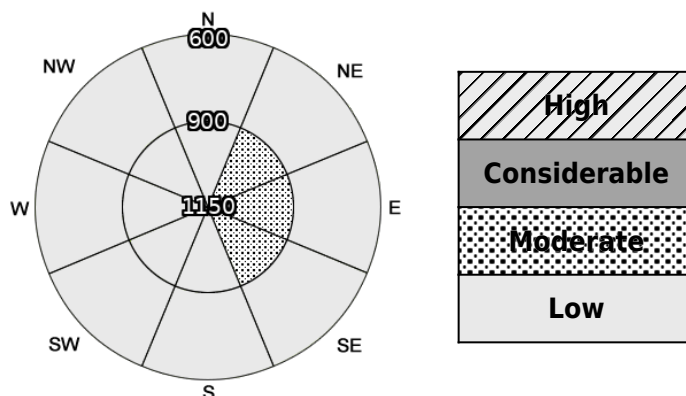
Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of moderately bonded windslab will persist mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Greatest amounts will be found in steep lee terrain such as corrie rims, gully exits and scarp slopes. A dusting of snow will be found on other aspects with older snow very firm, icy and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain sub 700 metres throughout with light amounts of snowfall overnight. Winds strong North-North-West overnight but veering and easing to the North before strengthening slightly to the South-South-East in the afternoon.

##### Comments

Some snowfall overnight but a dry sunny day is likely.
