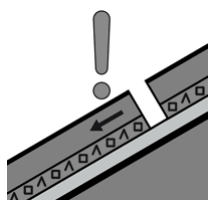


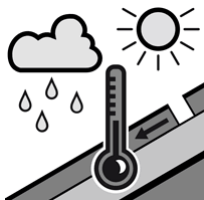

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 21/03/2020

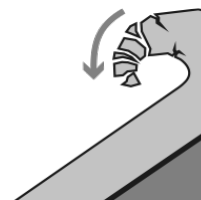

Persistent Weak Layers



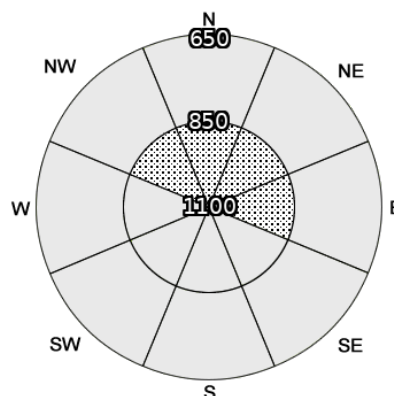
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected within the snowpack. Weaknesses will persist in the windslab at higher levels, mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 850 metres. Large cornices remain above North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be South-Easterly, moderate during the evening then strengthening to be strong during the day. It will be dry, with the freezing level around 500 metres overnight rising to 800 metres during the day.

Comments

High pressure is expected to keep it dry and settled for a few days but with stronger winds.
