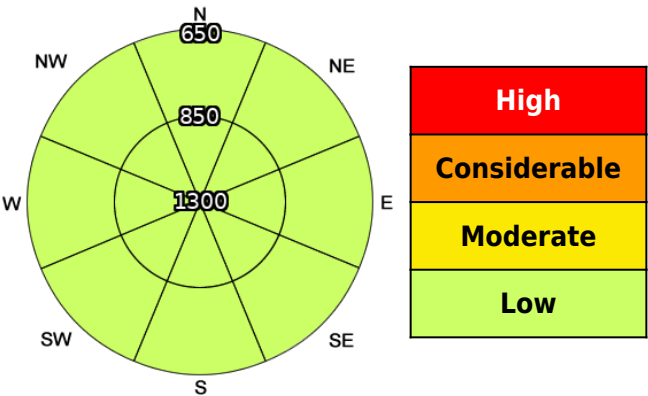
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to stabilise, however isolated instabilities will remain in windslab on South through West to North-West aspects above 1000 metres. Areas specifically affected will be steep, high wind sheltered areas such as coire rims, gully tops and ridge flanks. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light Easterly winds will strengthen to moderate and back Northerly during the day. It will be a generally overcast day with light snow showers developing in the afternoon. The freezing level will drop to around 600 metres.
