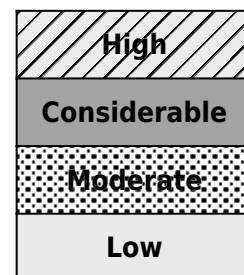
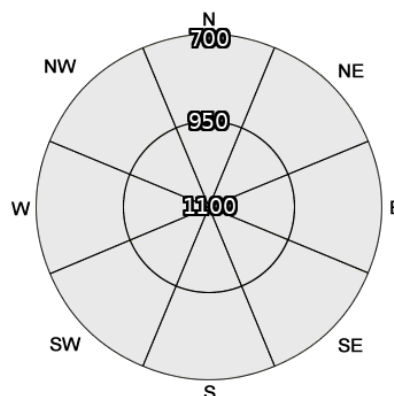
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in all locations until the onset of snow showers at dawn. New humid reasonably bonded windslab will begin to build on steep, sheltered West to North aspects above 950m. New accumulations expected to be limited in depth and extent. All wind exposed aspects will be scoured and well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A few sporadic overnight light snow showers over summits then dry. Most organised snow showers from dawn onwards for a few hours. Freezing level near summits but rising a little higher later. Strong SE airflow during showers.

Comments

Some limited new windslab development at highest elevations expected from dawn onwards.
