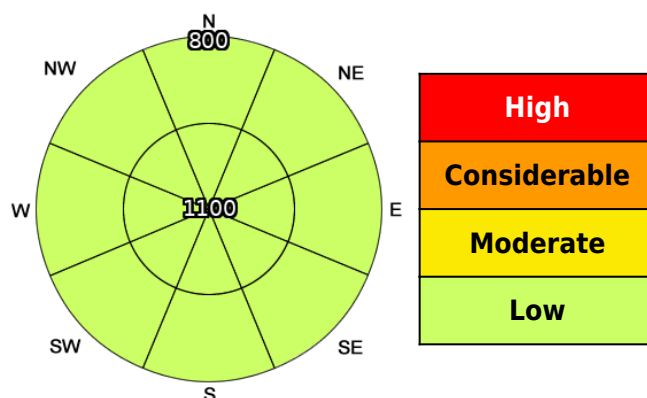
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will be generally stable and during the day its surface will start to refreeze at higher levels. Some fresh windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 950 metres. Any accumulations gaining depth are not expected to be extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will remain above the summits, then during the day gradually lower to around 1000 metres. Winds will be strong Southerly. During the day some light snowfall is expected above around 900 metres.

Comments

There is medium confidence for snowfall amounts. If there is more snowfall than noted above the avalanche hazard should be adjusted accordingly.
