

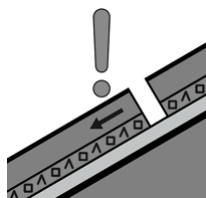

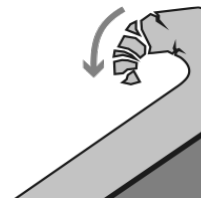

Wind Slab



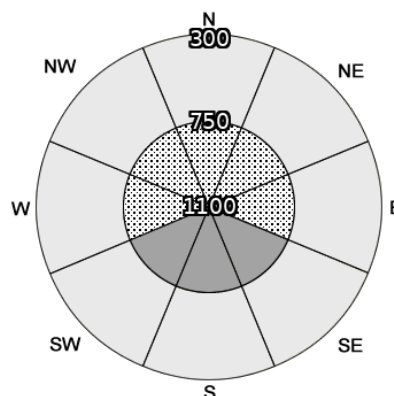
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Colder temperatures will maintain weaknesses at depth in all significant windslab accumulations although a dense layer of snow will maintain a supportive bridge over these suspect layers. Most affected areas will be gully tops and coire rims of all aspects above 900 metres. Localised deposits of weak windslab will continue to build on steeper South-East through South to South-West aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Generally dry but a few light snow showers on moderate North or North-East winds. Remaining cold throughout.
