

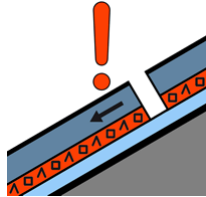

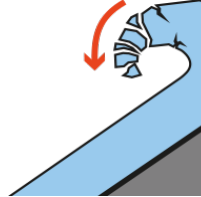
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



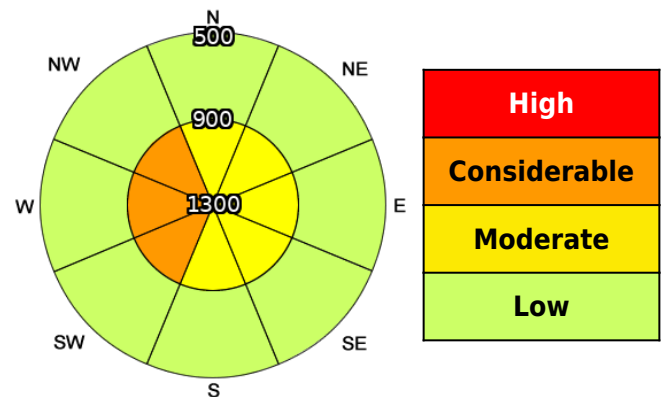
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist above 900 metres. Greatest instability will be above 1000 metres on South-West to North-West aspects, especially around steep convex terrain, coire rims and gully exits. Cornices overhanging these areas will be unstable. More localised instabilities will be evident in steep locations on many other aspects, particularly South and North. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snowfall throughout the forecast period on moderate North-Easterly winds. Remaining cold with a freezing level of around 500 metres.

Comments

A variable snowpack with soft layers beneath firm windslab leading to instabilities in steep locations.
