

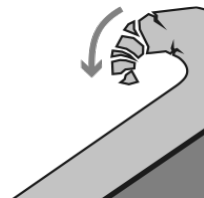

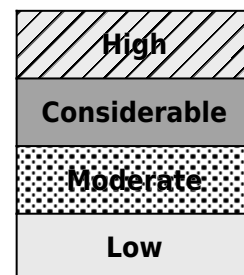
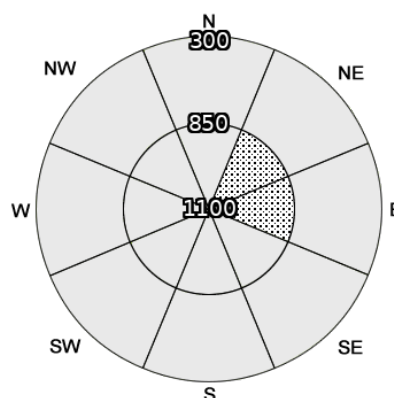
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate in most locations with good stability below 850 metres. Above this altitude accumulations of new marginally bonded windblown deposits will develop; mainly on North-East to Easterly aspects. The areas most affected will be steep gully flanks and exits. Some new cornice development will develop above these aspects; all cornices around coire rims will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be further snow showers above 600 metres throughout . The freezing level will fluctuated early in the period before rising steadily as the day progresses; snow at summits will turn to sleet with rain at lower elevations. The West-North-West and West winds will strengthen and become West-South West from first light.
