

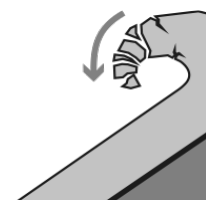

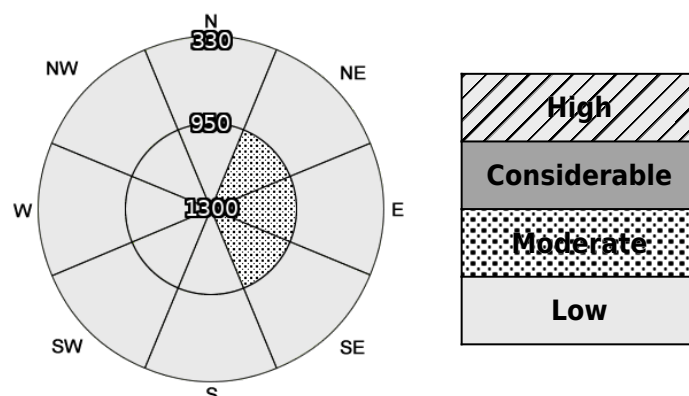
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of unstable windslab will persist on steep and sheltered North-East to South-East aspects mainly above 950 metres. Areas especially affected will be around coire rims, gully exits and convexities. Fragile cornices will overhang these areas. Isolated windslab will remain on North aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere will be generally wind scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers during the night, these are expected to clear to leave a dry day. Strong West-South-Westerly winds will gradually ease moderate to light and back to the South-West. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.

Comments

Snow showers decreasing, heavy snowfall is possible later in the week.
