

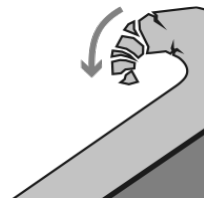

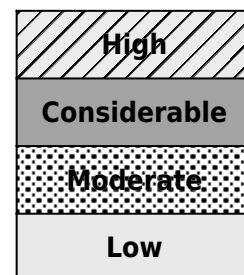
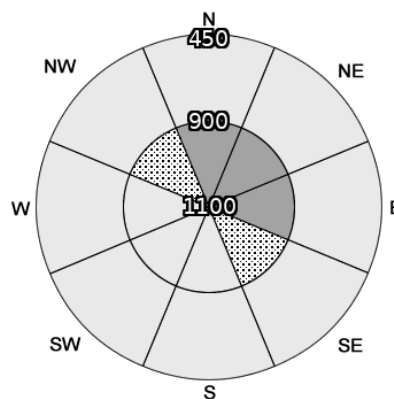
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of moderately to poorly bonded windslab will exist primarily on steep North to East aspects above 900m, some more localised build up also on North-West and South-Easterly aspects. Areas particularly affected will be steep gully flanks and exit, and around coire rims. Good stability below 800 metres and in all wind exposed locations. New cornice development will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be some further snow showers early in the period. It will remain cool with the strong West-South-Westerly winds easing South-West.

Comments

Very sparse cover below 450 metres; best above 600 metres.
