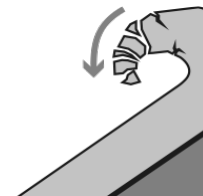

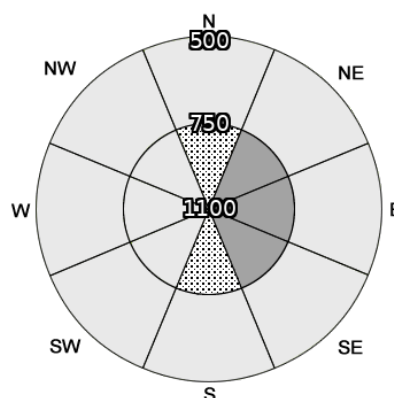

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weak new windslab will be present on all steep NE through E to SE aspects above 750m. Much of this new windslab will develop on top of a weak layer of surface hoar. Stability declining during the course of the day. Avalanches likely. Fragile and collapse prone new cornices also expected over very steep locations of the same aspects later in the period. Much better stability on ridge lines all recently wind scoured slopes and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers throughout, heaviest from before dawn to mid morning. Cold. Light N winds becoming moderate to strong NW, later WNW.

Some uncertainty over forecasted snow amounts for our area by different agencies. May receive more or less than indicated in the avalanche forecast.
