

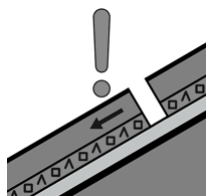

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 24/01/2021

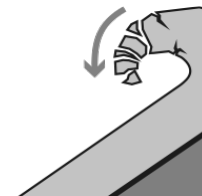

Wind Slab



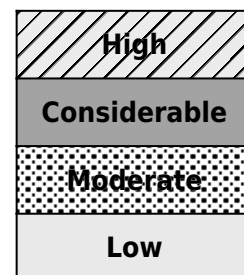
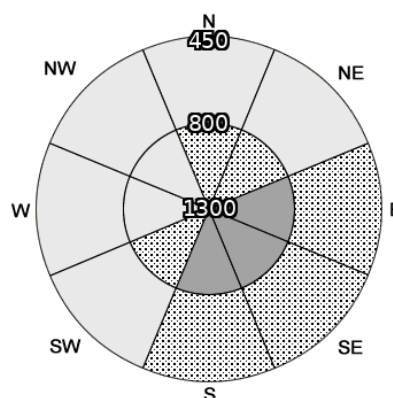
Persistent Weak Layers

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will persist on steep East to South aspects above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. More localised accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will persist on South-West and North-East aspects and will develop on North aspects during the day. Localised instabilities will be present at lower elevations on East to South aspects. Slopes exposed to the wind will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a cold dry day with light to moderate South-Westerly winds. It will be freezing at all levels with a Cairngorm summit temperature of around -8 degrees C.

##### Comments

Fresh cornices present at most levels and will be a hazard in poor visibility. Remaining cold.
