

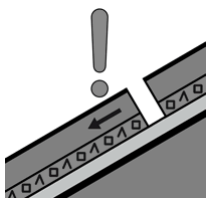

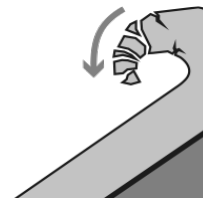

Wind Slab



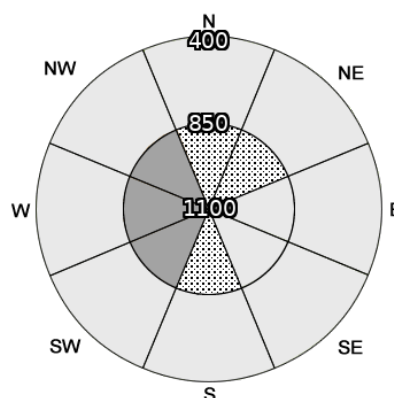

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Strong winds will encourage further snow redistribution and weaker windslab build up on very steep SW through W to NW aspects above 850m. Cross loading also possible on some very sheltered and steep N and S facing gullies. Dormant deeper persistent weaknesses will remain in some NE facing gullies. Any new cornices will be weak. Heavily scoured wind exposed aspects and all ridges will offer best safe travel options. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Only light showers are forecast. Strong Easterly airflow throughout. Persistently cold.

Comments

Some uncertainty over forecasted snowfall amounts. Very conservative route choice advised in the event of heavier, more persistent snow.
