

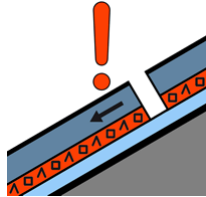

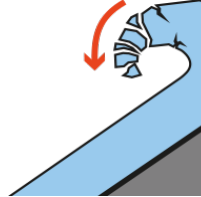
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



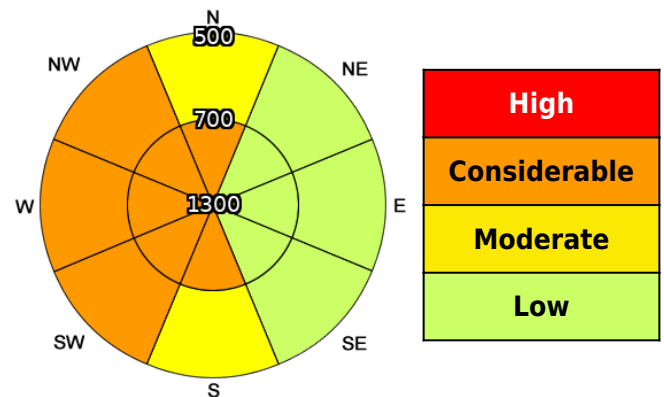
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poor to moderately bonded windslab will persist in steep and convex terrain on South-West to North-West aspects above 500 metres and be most widespread above 700 metres. Any cornices above these aspects are fragile. Instabilities will also persist on North and South aspects. Any slopes exposed to the recent strong winds will be generally scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a cold dry day with light to moderate East-North-Easterly winds. It will be freezing at all levels with a Cairngorm summit temperature of around -10 degrees C.
