

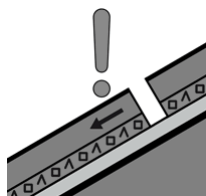

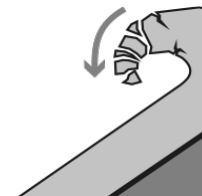

Wind Slab



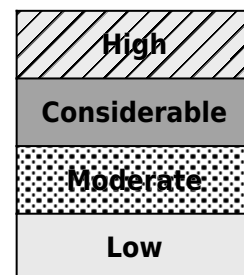
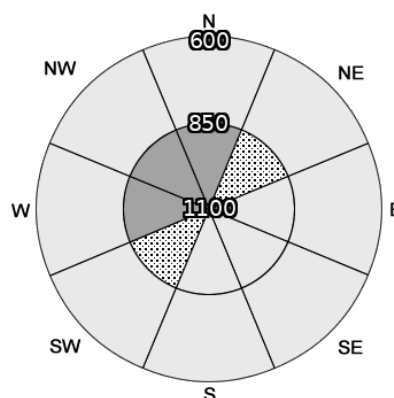

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Strong winds will continue to redistribute snow as weak windslab on to very sheltered and steep W to N aspects above 850m where accumulations are expected to be localised. Deeper cold induced weaknesses will remain beneath all old and new windslab in the same locations. Better stability on all low angled terrain and most places at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

No precipitation is forecast. Remaining cold with strong SSE or SE winds.
