

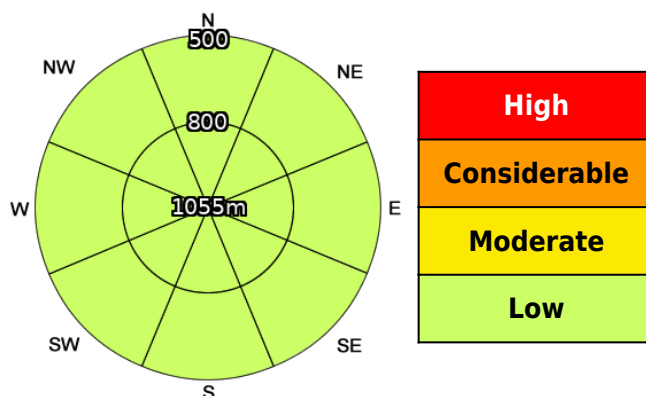

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate and remain generally stable. Snow cover will be patchy below 600 metres with better but sometimes broken cover at higher elevations. The snowpack will remain firm, above 800 metres, particularly on exposed summit terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a wet evening it will be dry through the night and for most of the day with some showers developing towards the end of the afternoon. Moderate South-South-Westerly winds overnight will decrease slightly, then veer to South-East and increase gradually to strong throughout the day. The freezing level will be above the summits throughout the forecast period.

Comments

Freezing levels lowering slightly on Sunday and Monday.
