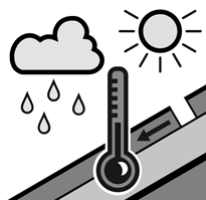


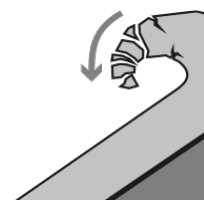

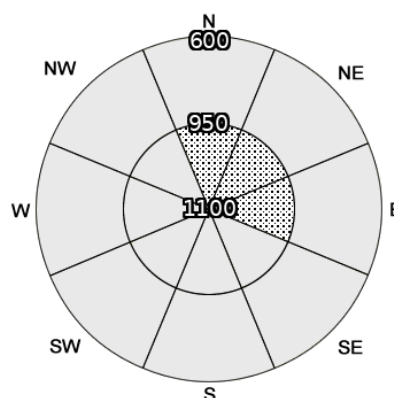
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in most locations. Some wet snow instability during the day on N to E aspects but this will be limited to very steep ground above 950m. The patchy, moist snowpack at lower altitudes will remain well bonded and stable. Older and more recent cornices will become weaker later during milder conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few snow showers very early in the period then dry. Moderate WSW or SW winds. Remaining cool overnight then noticeably milder from just after dawn onwards.

Comments

Older and more recent cornices expected to weaken during the day.
