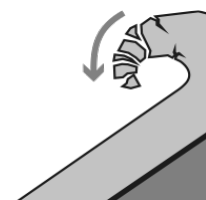


### THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 01/03/2021

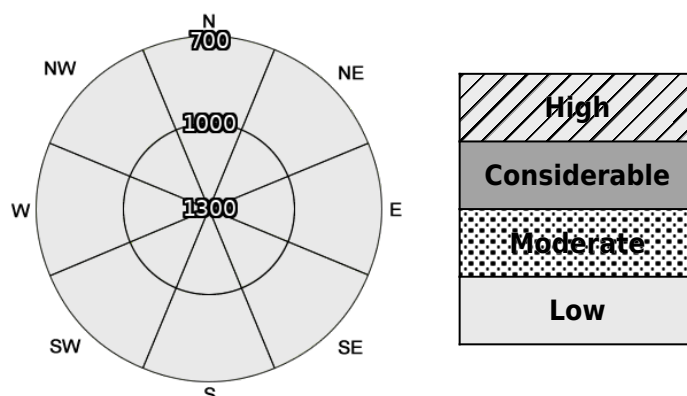
##### Avalanche Problems

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and remain generally well bonded and stable throughout. Due to the forecast temperature inversion, the snowpack is expected to be hard and icy at all levels. It is only expected to soften on sun affected aspects and lower elevations later in the day. Any remaining cornices exposed to the sun may be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Light Southerly winds are expected throughout the forecast period. No precipitation is forecast. The freezing level is expected to be well above summit levels. However, due to a strong temperature inversion, the temperature at lower elevations will be significantly lower.

##### Comments

High pressure is continuing to dominate over Scotland bringing more settled, dry weather with light winds. The remaining snowpack is hard and icy in places with serious runouts.
