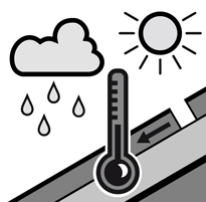

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 01/03/2021

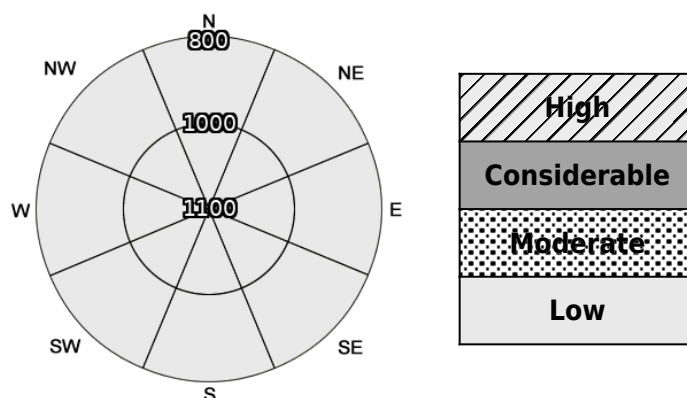
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. The slow steady thaw will continue at all elevations. The remaining snowpack, which lies primarily on North to East aspects above 800 metres, although moist, will remain generally well bonded and stable. Cornice lines around coire rims, which are in the main small, will continue to slump and collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure with settled conditions; it will remain dry and mild throughout. Temperature inversion conditions on summits during the day, although the effective Freezing Level for the snowline will stay around 1000m. The fresh SW winds will ease light S and SSE
