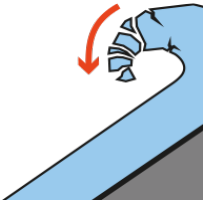

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 02/03/2021

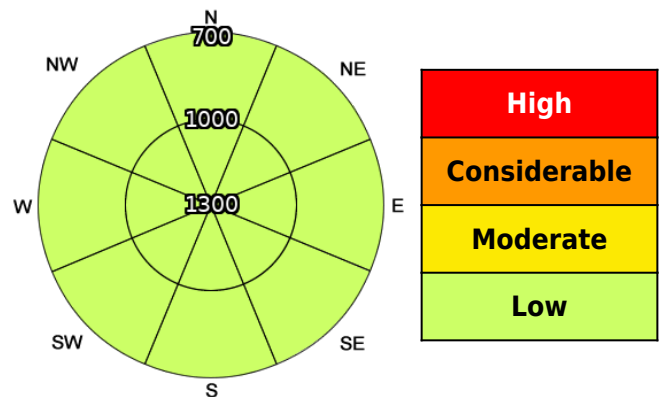
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable throughout. Due to the forecast temperature inversion, the snowpack is expected to be hard and icy at all levels. It is only expected to soften on sun affected aspects later in the day. Any remaining cornices exposed to the sun may be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light South-East winds veering South then West by the end of the forecast period. Another dry, clear and sunny day is expected. The freezing level will be above the summits. However, due to a temperature inversion, the temperature at lower elevations will be significantly lower.

Comments

High pressure is continuing to dominate, bringing more settled, dry weather with light winds. The remaining snowpack is hard and icy with serious runouts.
