

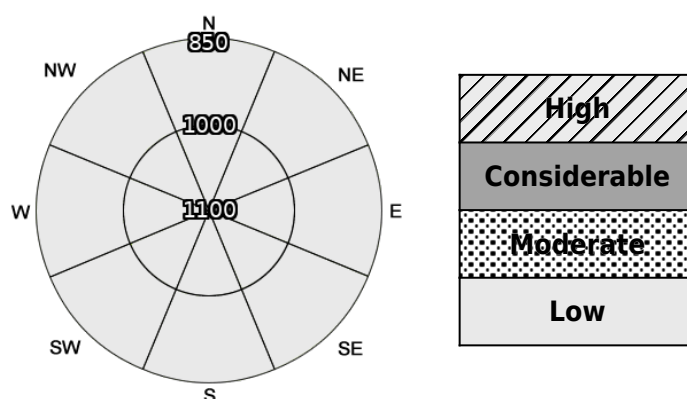

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 08/03/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Existing accumulations on NW through N to NE aspects at all elevations will remain well stabilised. Some new thin windslab accumulations are possible around summit elevations on North-East to Easterly aspects above 950m. Any new accumulations are expected to consolidate rapidly and to be limited in distribution. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight a series of weak weather fronts will bring some sleet and snow to summit elevations; these will largely die away from first light. The WSW winds will moderate to fresh Westerly then WSW again.
