

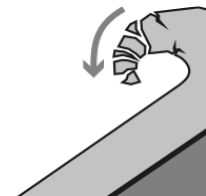

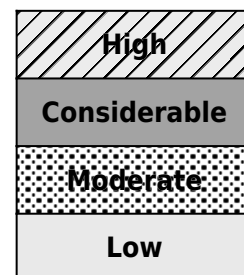
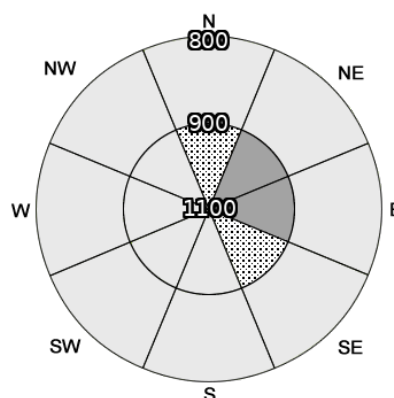
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will exist and become more widespread on North-East through East to South-Easterly aspects above 900m as the day progresses. Most affected areas will be very steep gully exits and coire rims. New fragile cornice development expected above steeper lee slopes of the same aspects. Better stability on all windward slopes above 800m, where hard conditions underfoot will prevail. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers throughout the period. The Freezing Level will be around 500 metres overnight rising slightly to 600 metres by end of the period. The strong WSW airflow will ease NW overnight, increasing again, mainly W and WNW later.
