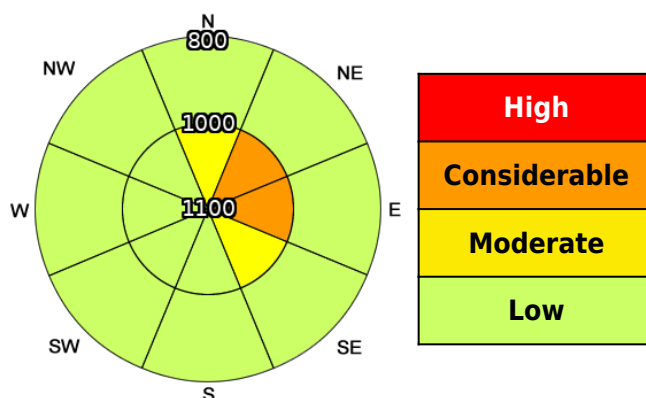

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist within localised accumulations of marginally stabilised windslab, on mainly North-East through East to South-Easterly aspects above 1000m; elsewhere the snowpack will continue to consolidate. New cornice development will remain above steeper lee slopes of the same aspects. Good stability on all windward slopes, where older accumulations will remain hard, re-frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After some isolated snow showers early in the period, it will be dry overnight and during the day. The Freezing Level, initially around 700 metres will rise to around summit level after midday. The fresh WNW airflow will start to ease and back West, then West-South-Westerly later.
