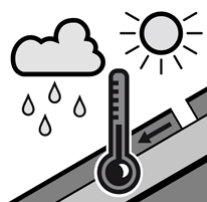


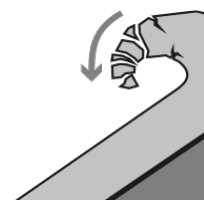

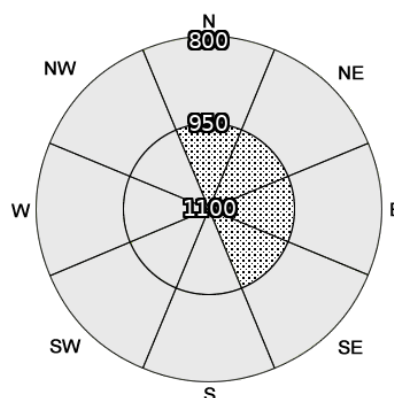
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A brief period of instability before dawn on N through E to ESE aspects above 950m as the most recent windslab weakens in response to milder, moister conditions. Large cornices above these locations will be prone to collapse at this time, too. Consolidation of all snow expected from morning onwards with onset of drier, cooler weather. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming milder with some very light overnight rain then drier, clearer, cooler later in the morning. Light SW winds becoming strong NW by morning.

Comments

Large cornices will be prone to collapse during the early mild and moist conditions.
