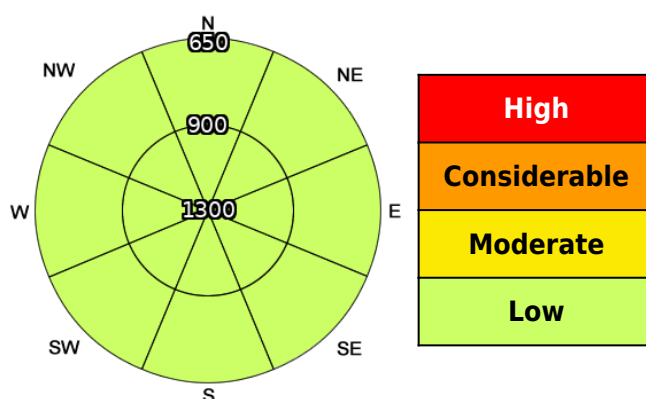


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 22/03/2021****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain well bonded and stable throughout. It will be firm above 1000 metres at first, gradually softening in all locations during the day. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and diminish with very patchy cover below 900 metres, better cover above and good cover on summit plateau areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a dry cloudy day, the freezing level will rise from 1000 metres overnight to around 1300 metres during the day. Winds will be moderate West-South-Westerly.

Milder and windy on Tuesday, then slightly colder again on Wednesday.
