

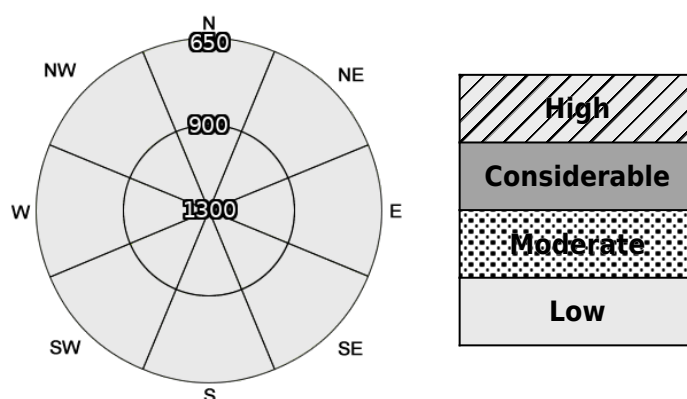

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 23/03/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change within the snowpack is expected. The snowpack will be firm, well consolidated and stable at all altitudes. The snow cover will remain very patchy below 900m more extensive above this altitude and good cover on summit plateaus. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will fluctuate around the summits. The wind will back from West-South-West to South-South-West and become strong to gale force. No precipitation is expected.

Comments

Strong winds set to continue for the next few days. Rock and ice fall will remain a potential hazard below crag faces.
