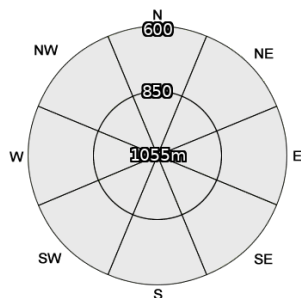


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 22/03/2021 TO 18:00HRS Tue 23/03/2021



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be South-South-West throughout the period initially strong, increasing to gale force by the afternoon. There will be light showers tomorrow morning, with the possibility of sleet on the highest summits later. The freezing level will be around 1100 metres.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be well bonded and stable, soft and moist at all elevations. The snowpack will remain patchy with the greatest cover on North to East aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Mon 22/03/2021

Observed Weather Influences

A day of poor visibility and drizzle with some brighter spells at glen level. Winds were moderate South-West. The freezing level was above the summits.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack is patchy and continues to slowly diminish at all elevations. It is well bonded, stable and moist in most locations. The best cover is on North to East aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard is Low.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

Diminishing snowpack, good above 850 metres in the high corries. Poor visibility throughout the day on the summits. Winds approx 10-20 mph and fresh in nature.

Comments

Possibility of sleet on the highest summits with rain elsewhere tomorrow. Amounts are expected to be light.
