

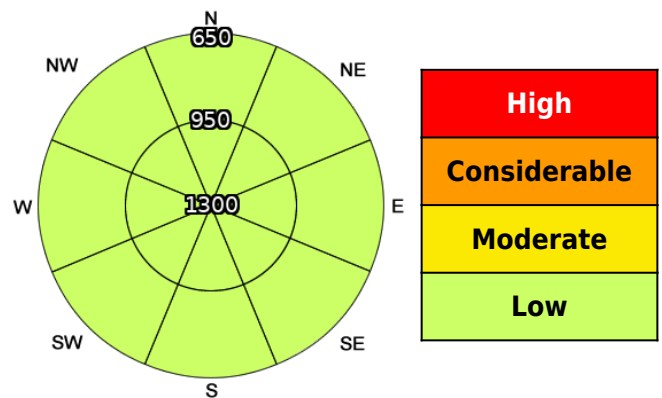

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 03/04/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain firm, icy and stable in all locations following an overnight freeze. The snow surface will gradually soften over the course of the day, especially where exposed directly to the sun. Greatest cover will be above 950 metres on all aspects, particularly around coire headwalls and plateau areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry and sunny day is expected with no precipitation forecast. The freezing level will be around 500 metres overnight rising to 1200 metres by the end of the day. Winds will be generally West-North-West and moderate in strength.

Comments

A bright day in prospect for tomorrow. The snow surface will however be firm and icy following an overnight radiation freeze, softening gradually or where exposed to direct sunlight.
