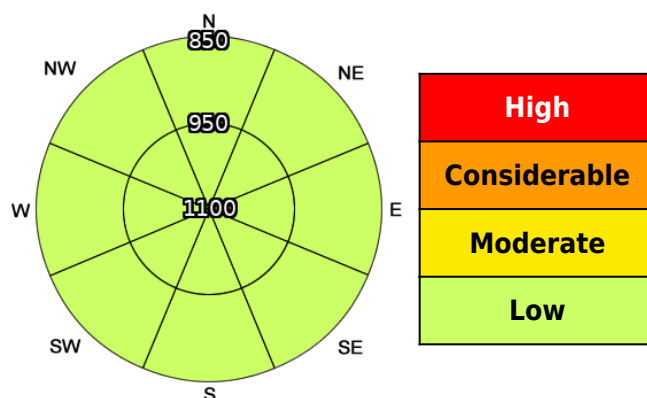
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overall stability will remain good but from midday thin windslab will begin to build on steep North-East through East to South-East aspects above 950m. These limited accumulations will be confined to gully exits and coire rims. The old patchy snowpack will remain firm and well bonded in all other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and clear overnight. Colder with some light snowfall late in the morning carried on a strong Westerly airflow.
