

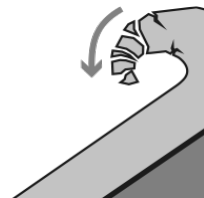

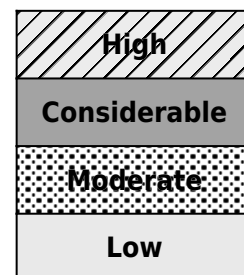
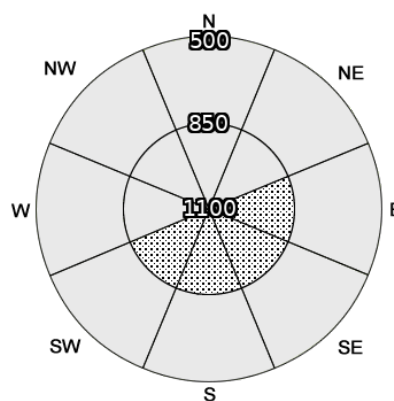
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas throughout the period, mainly on East through South to South-West aspects above 850 metres. Accumulations will build throughout the period. The tops of gullies and around coire rims will be most affected. The old snowpack will be frozen and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be strong mainly North-North-Westerly. Light snow showers at all levels will continue throughout the period.
