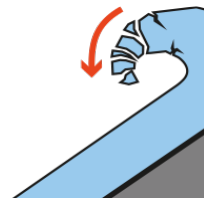
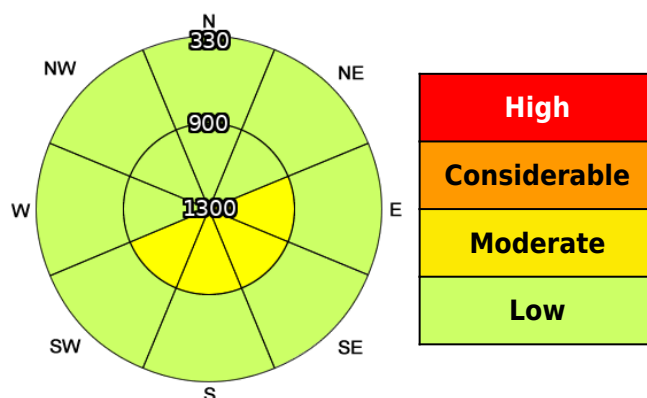


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 07/04/2021****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Accumulations of unstable windslab will continue to develop on steep East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Instabilities will be most significant where accumulations gain depth in wind sheltered locations, such as gully tops and coire rims. Cornices above these aspects will be fragile. Slopes exposed to the recent strong winds will remain scoured, firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry overcast day with no precipitation forecast. It will be freezing at all levels overnight, the freezing level gradually rising to 400 metres during the day. North-Westerly winds will be strong overnight gradually decreasing to moderate through the day.

Comments

Remaining wintry for the next few days, although slightly milder for a spell on Thursday.
