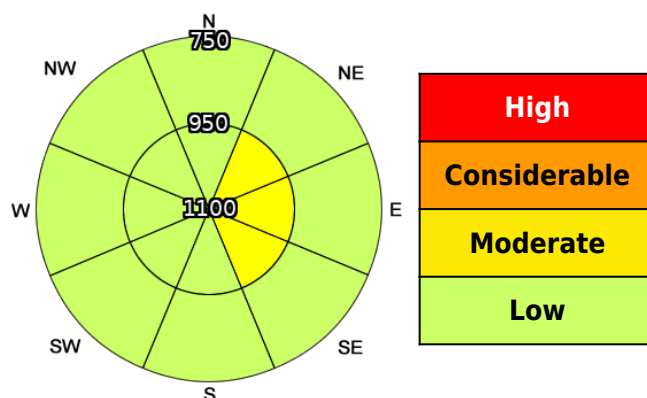
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Small pockets of new windblown snow will persist on steep, mainly East to South-Easterly aspects; most affected areas will be the very top of coire rims and gully exits above 950m. Accumulations of older dry windslab will be present on North-East to East aspects above 1000m. Good stability in all other locations and altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The influence of a cold North-Westerly arctic airflow will persist; mainly dry overnight with fresh wind accompanied by occasional light snow showers after midday.
