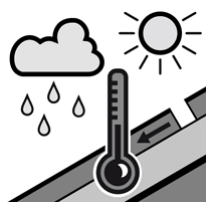

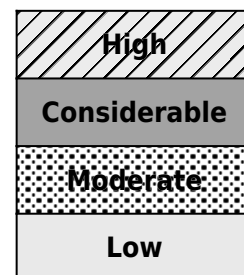
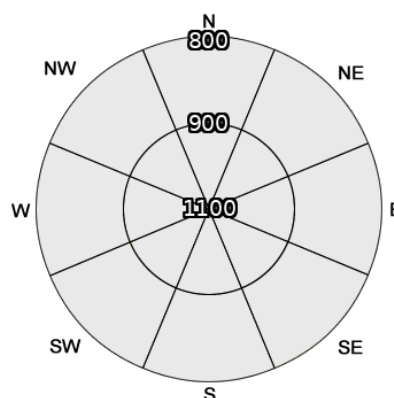
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised instability will persist on some very steep North-East to East aspects above 900m. Some minor sluffing possible later in the day as the freezing level rises. Elsewhere the snowpack will become moist but be generally well bonded. Selected steep SE to E aspects will be overhung by older cornices. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry though a few late snow showers are possible. Light variable winds. Frost at all levels overnight but progressively less cold during daylight hours.
