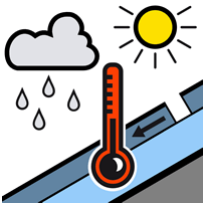

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 15/04/2021

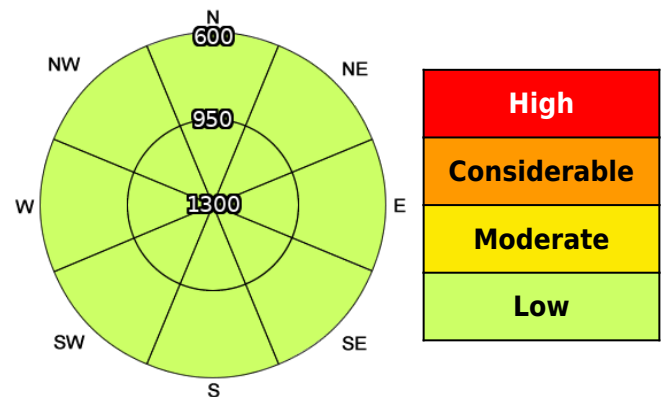
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will gradually thaw and diminish but remain stable in most locations. Isolated wet snow surface instabilities may develop on very steep East to South aspects above 950 metres, where exposed to the strong sunlight. Greatest snow cover remains above 950 metres, very patchy below. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will bring a dry sunny day. The freezing level will gradually rise to 1400 metres. Light Southerly winds will increase slightly towards the end of the afternoon.

Comments

High pressure remaining through Friday and Saturday giving dry sunny weather with overnight frost and the freezing level rising above the summits during the day.
