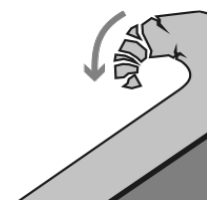


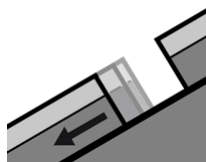

##### Avalanche Problems



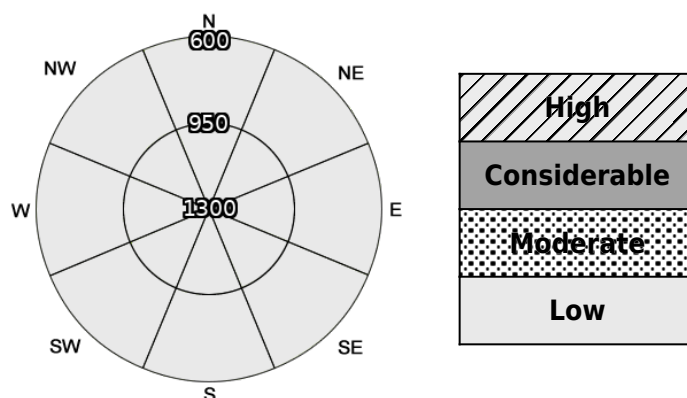

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The stable snowpack will become firm overnight before thawing and softening though the day. Northerly facing slopes will remain generally firm. The greatest snow cover will be around corrie back walls and plateau areas above 950 metres. Glide cracks will continue to widen within areas where the snowpack overlies steep slabby terrain. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions throughout the forecast period with strong Southerly winds. It will be cooler during the night but the freezing level will remain above the summits.

##### Comments

Rock and icefall will remain a hazard during the thaw conditions. Steep slopes on some Northerly aspects will present serious run out potential in the event of an un-arrested slip or fall.
