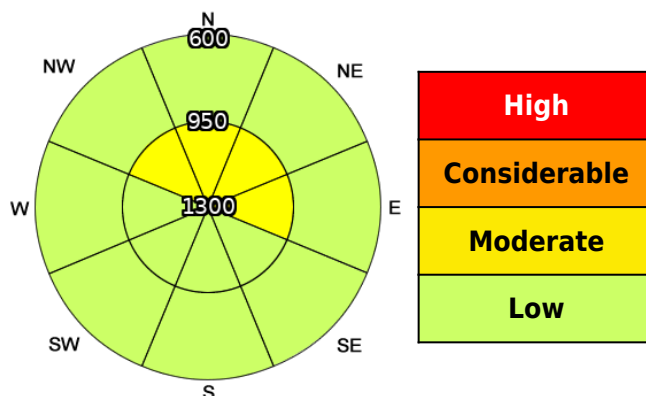


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 08/05/2021****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The existing snowpack although soft, will continue to improve in stability and will be good in most areas. Localised instabilities will persist though on E aspects above 1100m, in isolated steep windslab convexities. As the day progresses, accumulations of new and drifting snow will build unstable deposits on West through North to North-Easterly aspects, mostly above 950m with gully exits, coire rims and scarp slopes most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Dry overnight with precipitation developing and falling as snow above 800m from mid morning, then throughout the day. Winds North-Westerly in the evening veering overnight becoming South-Easterly and strengthening to severe gale by mid afternoon.

Comments

Generally stable conditions in widespread soft snow cover. Strengthening winds and snow expected with drifting
