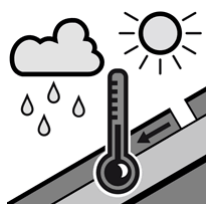


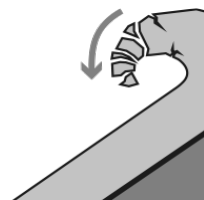

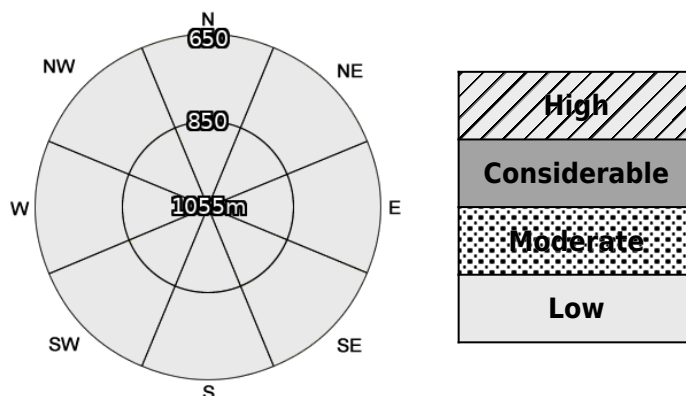

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The shallow snow cover will thaw and diminish at all elevations. Although snowpack stability will generally be good, some surface wet snow instabilities are possible in the steepest locations where the snow gains depth, mainly on East, through South to West aspects above 850 metres. Any remaining cornices will become fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

With freezing levels maintaining well above the summits, showery rain is expected at all elevations through the day. The strong, generally South-East airflow will quickly ease for a time this evening, becoming moderate to fresh thereafter.

Comments

The freezing level is expected to remain above all summits into next week, with significant snowmelt expected. Back to unsettled milder spring-like conditions!
