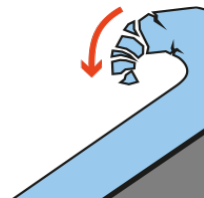
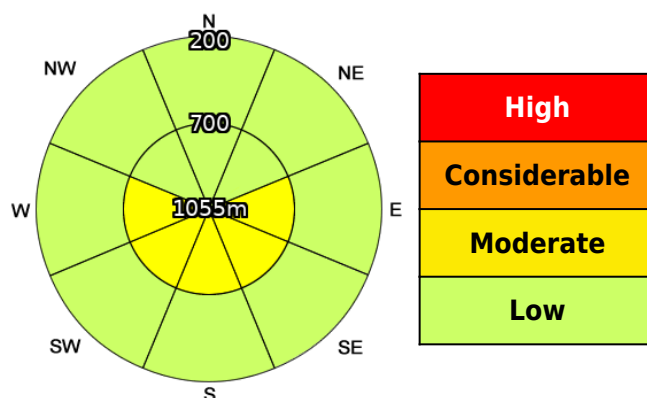


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 27/11/2021****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to develop throughout the period, affecting wind sheltered locations, particularly on steep East through South to West aspects above 700 metres. Otherwise, the snow cover will be shallow and sparse and scoured on wind exposed areas. Cross loading will affect other aspects, most notably in gullies and runnels. Fresh cornice growth is expected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Wintry showers will continue throughout the period with snow lying around glen levels as the freezing level lowers to 200 metres overnight. Severe Northerly gales will gradually ease, becoming fresh to strong by the end of the period.

**Comments**

Another very wintry day expected. However, the wind will ease slightly, but it will remain very cold with poor visibility during showers. Scoured windward areas will be icy in places.
