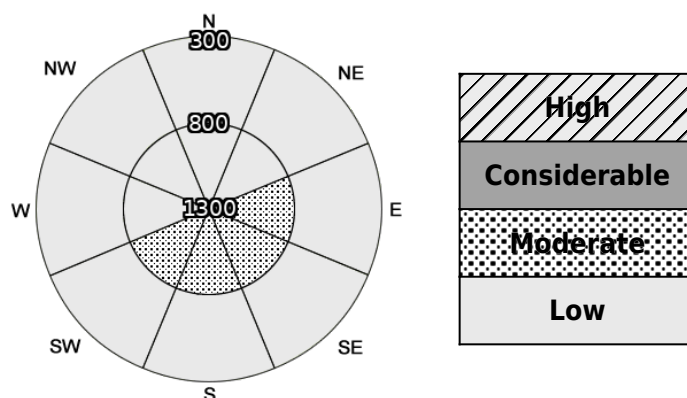
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas throughout the period. Greatest accumulations will be on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. West aspects will be affected by cross-loading. Windward areas exposed to the strong winds will generally be scoured and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be very strong Northerly overnight, then easing gradually during the day but remaining strong. The freezing level will be around 300 metres. Snow showers at all levels are expected throughout the period.

Comments

Another cold wintry day is expected.
