

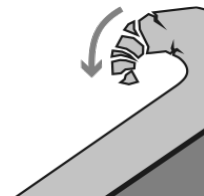

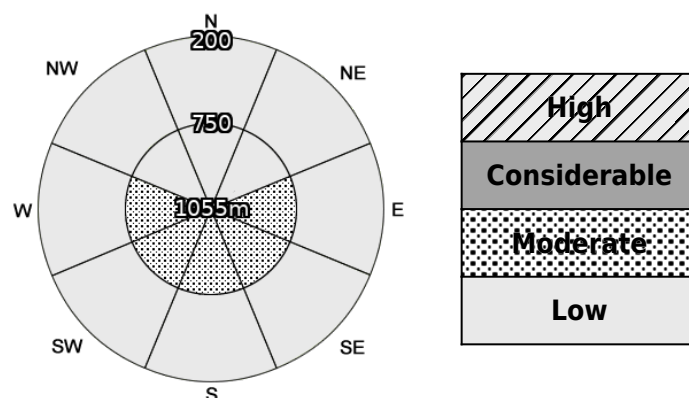
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold conditions will maintain instabilities in localised areas of windslab building in steep wind sheltered locations, East through South to West aspects and mainly above 750 metres. Most affected will be coire rims, tops of gullies and ridge flanks. Otherwise, the general snow cover will remain shallow and sparse in places with windward areas scoured. Expect some new cornice growth. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight and through the morning will ease by the afternoon. It will remain cold, although the freezing level will rise to around 500 metres by mid morning, lowering slightly later. The fresh Northerly wind will moderate overnight, backing West for a time before strengthening North through the day.

Comments

It will remain cold with a high windchill at summit levels. Snow showers will ease in the afternoon giving a clearer end to the period. Exposed scoured terrain will be icy in places.
