



##### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present, with greatest accumulations on East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. West aspects will also be affected by recent cross-loading and some fresh windslab will be deposited on higher North-East aspects during the day. Many windward slopes that have been exposed to recent strong winds will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Wind are expected to initially be strong North-North-Westerly, easing and backing Westerly overnight before veering and strengthening during the day to moderate strength North-North-Westerly. Cold with the freezing level rising during the day to around 450 metres. Dry overnight; light snowfall during the morning.
