





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to deplete at all levels in the heavy thaw conditions. At first wet snow instabilities will increase and the snowpack will be unstable overnight with some improved stability later as the snowpack thaws. These wet snow instabilities will mainly affect East through South to West aspects above 750 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The strong North-West winds will reduce in strength overnight, becoming fresh variable West-North-Westerly and be North-West by the end of the period. Heavy rain is expected with some light sleet and snow showers on the summits. The freezing level will be around summit levels overnight then rising to above summit levels later.

Comments

The thaw continues, wet snow instabilities increasing, There will be improved stability later in the period as the snow depletes.
