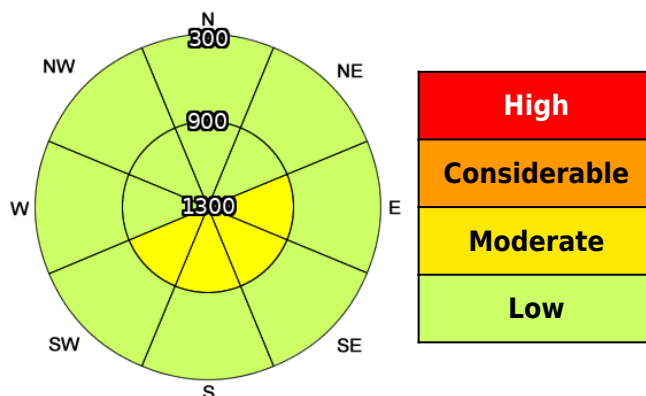

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will become firm well bonded and stable throughout. New unstable windslab will develop on East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Greatest instability will be within steep wind sheltered locations where new accumulations gain depth. Fragile cornices will begin to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Turning cooler during the night with rain and sleet turning to snow. Moderate North-Westerly winds will veer towards the North and increase moderate to strong. The freezing level will steadily fall from summit levels to 400 metres by the end of the day.

Comments

A return to cooler temperatures with snowfall.
